- I. Call to Order  
The Public Works Committee for the Village of Campton Hills was called to order by the chairman Dave Newkirk at 7:00 p.m. on Wednesday May 6, 2015 at the Campton Township Community Center 5N002 Old LaFox Road in the Village of Campton Hills, Kane county Illinois.
- II. Present at Roll Call

- III. Approval of Minutes  
The minutes of the previous meeting (November 11, 2014) were accepted by voice vote with no nays voiced.
- IV. Request for public comment – No guests present for comment
- V. Old Business -
- 2015 Major Street Program  
Dave reported that repaving of Crawford Road will be the major resurfacing project for 2015. The budget for this project is \$150K. This project will include cutting down trees that are close to the edge of the roadway. The project does not include installing guard rails above the culverts. Dave reported that he would like to see the speed limit reduced to 35 mph.
- 2015 Crack Sealing  
Dave reported that the Campton Township crews are too busy to do crack sealing this year on the portions of the village roads that were formerly in Plato Township. As a result, the village will contract with a private company to do the crack sealing. Areas to be done include the roads in Arlington Estates, Tall Pines Rd and Kendall Road. The budget for this project is \$15K.
- VI. New Business
- Future Projects  
With the repaving of Crawford road, the village will have resurfaced all of the roads in the original Plato Township portion of the Village. Dave suggested that for the next few years, the funds the village typically spent on resurfacing roads in the portions of the village formerly in Plato Township should be spent on the roads in the village that were formerly in Campton Township. Many of these roads are in worse shape than the roads in the former Plato Township portions of the village.
- Currently the village funds the Campton Township Highway District to resurface and maintain these roads. This additional funding would accelerate the resurfacing of these roads. The committee discussed the role of the committed going forward including monitoring how the Campton Township Highway District uses the road resurfacing funding provided by the village.
- Subdivision Plan  
Dave reported that Public Works Committee's input is being incorporated into the Subdivision Plan being produced by the Village's Planning Commission. John Boveri volunteered to review the final draft of the Subdivision Plan.
