- B. Section 2.06(d) of Open Meetings Act (5 ILCS 120/2.06(d)) requires that public bodies review minutes of closed meetings for potential release approximately every six months. **Semi-annual review of closed meeting minutes is mandated.** Each public body shall periodically, but no less than semi-annually, meet to review minutes of all closed meetings. **At such meetings a determination shall be made, and reported in an open session** that (1) the need for confidentiality still exists as to all or part of those minutes or (2) that the minutes or portions thereof no longer require confidential treatment and are available for public inspection.
