

VILLAGE OF CAMPTON HILLS

**RESOLUTION URGING ILLINOIS STATE LEADERS TO RELEASE
NON-GENERAL FUND REVENUES PAYABLE TO LOCAL GOVERNMENTS**

WHEREAS, the State of Illinois has been operating without a Fiscal Year 2016 state budget since July 1, 2015; and

WHEREAS, the absence of a budget has resulted in the state withholding over \$150 million in revenue owed to municipal governments for lack of appropriation authority; and

WHEREAS, critical local services, such as road construction, maintenance, and repair; drainage improvements; and snow plowing services provided by the Village of Campton Hills and Campton Township (on behalf of the Village of Campton Hills) will remain unfunded or underfunded until state leaders take action to release local Motor Fuel Tax Funds; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Campton Hills along with 1) the Villages of Wayne, Gilberts, Hampshire, Maple Park, Pingree Grove, and South Elgin 2) the Burlington, Hampshire, Maple Park, Pingree Grove, Fox River and Countryside, Big Rock, and Kaneville Fire Districts; and 3) the Fox Valley Park District and Kane County Forest Preserve Police Departments rely upon the 9-1-1 services provided by Kane County Emergency Communications (KaneComm); and

WHEREAS, since September 2015, KaneComm has not received their state distribution of wireless funds which accounts for 25% of KaneComm's operating revenue; and

WHEREAS, beginning in January 1, 2016, KaneComm will not be receiving their state distribution of wireline funds which are used to fund necessary 9-1-1 capital improvements; and

WHEREAS, without these funds, the effectiveness of emergency services to reach citizens within KaneComm's jurisdiction will be in peril; and

WHEREAS, local use tax in the Village of Campton Hills accounts for more than 10% of the Village's operating revenue, and without these funds, the Village may be forced to immediately cut services; and

WHEREAS, many municipal budgets and state-wide basic services will also be negatively impacted without the release of video gaming fees and casino fees.


NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CAMPTON HILLS that we call upon the Governor and General Assembly to take action to immediately release all non-general fund revenues owed to local governments. These funds include revenues from the Motor Fuel Tax, Wireless Service Emergency Fund, Use Tax, Local Government Video Gaming Distributive Fund, and casino gaming;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution be forwarded to the Governor, Senate President, Senate Minority Leader, House Speaker, House Minority Leader, as well as the State Senators and Representatives serving the Village of Campton Hills, and the Illinois Municipal League.
