

RESOLUTION NO. R-22-01

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF A POLICE SQUAD VEHICLE FOR THE VILLAGE OF CAMPTON HILLS, KANE COUNTY, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, the Village of Campton Hills, Kane County, Illinois (the "*Village*") is a duly organized and existing municipal corporation created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois and under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, as from time to time supplemented and amended; and

WHEREAS, the Police Chief requested the Village to authorize the purchase of a squad vehicle for the Village's Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the Police Chief has received two quotes for police squad vehicles, and at present is awaiting information on availability. See Exhibit A and Exhibit B, the squad vehicle quotes, attached hereto and made a part hereof; and

WHEREAS, the Village President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Campton Hills (the "*Corporate Authorities*") deem it advisable and in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village to authorize the Police Chief to purchase a police squad vehicle.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Campton Hills, Kane County, Illinois, as follows

Section 1. That the above recitals and legislative findings are found to be true and correct and are hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in their entirety.

Section 2. That the Police Chief or his designees are hereby authorized to purchase a police squad vehicle, as generally described in either Exhibit A or Exhibit B attached hereto, in an amount not to exceed Forty-Seven Thousand Two Hundred Dollars (\$47,200).

Section 3. That the Police Chief, his designees, the officials and the officers of the Village are

further hereby authorized to undertake any actions on the part of the Village to complete the purchase of said police squad vehicle, including entering into any agreements or contracts for said purchase.

Section 4. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Resolution shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any other provision of this Resolution.


Section 5. All ordinances, resolutions, motions or orders in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 6. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval, and publication in the manner provided by law.
