

**A RESOLUTION OF THE VILLAGE OF CAMPTON HILLS, KANE COUNTY, ILLINOIS
CORRECTING A SCRIVENER'S ERROR IN RESOLUTION NUMBERING**

WHEREAS, the Village of Campton Hills, Kane County, Illinois (the "*Village*") is a duly organized and existing municipal corporation created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois and under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, as from time to time supplemented and amended; and

WHEREAS, the Village President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Campton Hills, Kane County, Illinois (the "*Corporate Authorities*") may from time to time amend a Village Resolution when it is determined to be necessary, desirable and in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the Village and its residents; and

WHEREAS, the Village passed two (2) Resolutions in 2021, and assigned the same Resolution Number to both Resolutions due to a Scrivener's Error; and

WHEREAS, the Village President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Campton Hills (the "*Corporate Authorities*") find that correcting this Error by renumbering one (1) of the Resolutions is necessary, desirable and in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the Village and its residents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Campton Hills, Kane County, Illinois, as follows

Section 1. That the above recitals and legislative findings are found to be true and correct and are hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in their entirety.

Section 2. That the Resolution entitled "*A Resolution to endorse the 2021 Climate Action Plan for the Chicago Region,*" passed by the Village Board on December 7, 2021, is hereby assigned the new Resolution Number R-21-16A. The Village Clerk is hereby directed to renumber this Resolution to reflect this change.

Section 3. That this Resolution is hereby re-adopted and approved by the Village Board verbatim, and only the Resolution Number is changed hereby.

Section 4. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Resolution shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any other provision of this Resolution.


Section 5. All ordinances, resolutions, motions or orders in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 6. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval, and publication in the manner provided by law.
