

ORDINANCE NO. O-21-12

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 1 OF TITLE 4 OF THE VILLAGE CODE OF CAMPTON HILLS, KANE COUNTY, ILLINOIS RELATED TO ESTABLISHMENT OF A LIQUOR LICENSE CLASSIFICATION FOR COOKING, ARTS AND CRAFTS SCHOOLS

WHEREAS, the Village of Campton Hills, Kane County, Illinois (the "*Village*") is a duly organized and existing municipal corporation created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois and under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, as from time to time supplemented and amended; and

WHEREAS, the Village President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Campton Hills, Kane County, Illinois (the "*Corporate Authorities*") may from time to time amend the text of the Campton Hills Village Code (the "*Code*") when it is determined to be necessary, desirable and in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the Village and its residents; and

WHEREAS, Article IV of the Liquor Control Act of 1934, 235 ILCS 5/4-1, et seq. (the "*Act*"), authorizes the Corporate Authorities to determine the number, kind and classification of licenses for the retail sale of alcoholic liquor and to establish such further regulations and restrictions upon the issuance of and operations under local licenses not inconsistent with law as the public good and convenience may require; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities have determined that a liquor license classification related to cooking schools and arts and crafts classes that allows for the sale of beer and wine to patrons for consumption while participating in classes is desirable; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities find that it is in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village to provide for the classification and regulations herein specified.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of

the Village of Campton Hills, Kane County, Illinois, as follows

Section 1. That the above recitals and legislative findings are found to be true and correct and are hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in their entirety.

Section 2. Section 4-1-2 (“*Definitions*”) of Chapter 1 (“*Alcoholic Beverages*”) of Title 4 (“*Business and License Regulations*”) of the Village Code of Campton Hills, Illinois, is hereby amended by adding the underlined language to read, as follows:

4-1-2: Definitions:

ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR: *****

ART STUDIO, ARTS AND CRAFTS SCHOOL: A business which offers arts or crafts classes in connection with the designing or creating of arts and crafts goods, including, but not limited to, paintings, pottery, ceramics, jewelry and sculptures.

BAR:*****

CLUB: *****

COOKING SCHOOL: A business which provides culinary instruction, both demonstration style and hands on, to persons of all levels of cooking experience.

Section 3. 4-1-10 (“*Classification and Terms of Licenses*”) of Chapter 1 (“*Alcoholic Beverages*”) of Title 4 (“*Business and License Regulations*”) of the Village Code of Campton Hills, Illinois, is hereby amended and adding the underlined language to read, as follows:

4-1-10: Classifications and Terms of Licenses:

X. Class U License (Cooking, Arts and Crafts Classes): Class U licenses shall authorize

the retail sale of beer and wine by a cooking school, art studio, or arts and crafts school or similar business within the premises specified, for consumption on the premises, but such sales shall be limited to persons on the premises for the purpose of attending the art, craft or cooking class and consumption may only occur while participating in the class. No exterior signage advertising alcohol is permitted. Licensee's gross revenue from the sale of beer and wine authorized by the licensee's liquor license may not exceed twenty percent (20%) of the gross revenue generated by licensee's business. Licensee shall maintain adequate books and records in accordance with generally accepted accounting standards, which shall clearly indicate gross revenue from the sale of beer and wine.

Section 4. Section 4-1-11 ("*License Fees*") of Chapter 1 ("*Alcoholic Beverages*") of Title 4 ("*Business and License Regulations*") of the Village Code of Campton Hills, Illinois, is hereby amended and adding the underlined language to read, as follows:

4-1-11: License Fees:

License	Fee	Term

Section 5. Section 4-1-12 ("*Number of Licenses*") of Chapter 1 ("*Alcoholic Beverages*") of Title 4 ("*Business and License Regulations*") of the Village Code of Campton Hills, Illinois, is hereby amended by deleting the following stricken language and adding the underlined language to read, as follows:

4-1-12: Number of Licenses

Section 6. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any other provision of this Ordinance.

Section 7. All ordinances, resolutions, motions or orders in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict


Section 8. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval, and publication in the manner provided by law.
