

ORDINANCE NO. O-21-14

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 5 OF TITLE 4 OF THE VILLAGE CODE OF CAMPTON HILLS, KANE COUNTY, ILLINOIS RELATED TO THE NUMBER OF VIDEO GAMING TERMINALS ON EACH LICENSED PREMISES

WHEREAS, the Village of Campton Hills, Kane County, Illinois (the "*Village*") is a duly organized and existing municipal corporation created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois and under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, as from time to time supplemented and amended; and

WHEREAS, the Village President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Campton Hills, Kane County, Illinois (the "*Corporate Authorities*") may from time to time amend the text of the Campton Hills Village Code (the "*Code*"); and

WHEREAS, the Illinois Video Gaming Act, 230 ILCS 40/1 *et. seq.*, authorizes the Corporate Authorities to permit up to six (6) video gaming terminals in each licensed establishment at any time, 230 ILCS 40/25 (e);

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Campton Hills, Kane County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. That the above recitals and legislative findings are found to be true and correct and are hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in their entirety.

Section 2. Section 4-5-5 ("*Regulations*") of Chapter 5 ("*Video Gaming*") of Title 4 ("*Business and License Regulations*") of the Village Code of Campton Hills, Illinois, is hereby amended by deleting the stricken language and by adding the underlined language to read, as follows:

4-5-5: REGULATIONS:

The following regulations apply to all licensed establishments operating a video gaming terminal on the licensed premises:

- A. A valid State video gaming license must be clearly displayed at all times.
- B. A valid Village video gaming license must be clearly displayed at all times.
- C. No more than ~~five (5)~~ six (6) video gaming terminals may be located on the licensed premises.

Section 3. If any section, paragraph, clause, or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any other provision of this Ordinance.

Section 4. All ordinances, resolutions, motions, or orders in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict

Section 5. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval, and publication in the manner provided by law.
