

**ORDINANCE NO. O-22-01**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 5 OF TITLE 4 OF THE VILLAGE CODE OF CAMPTON HILLS, KANE COUNTY, ILLINOIS RELATED TO THE FEES IMPOSED ON VIDEO GAMING TERMINALS WITHIN THE VILLAGE.**

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Campton Hills, Kane County, Illinois (the "*Village*") is a duly organized and existing municipal corporation created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois and under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, as from time to time supplemented and amended; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Campton Hills, Kane County, Illinois (the "*Corporate Authorities*") may from time to time amend the text of the Campton Hills Village Code (the "*Code*"); and

**WHEREAS**, the Illinois Video Gaming Act, 230 ILCS 40/1 *et. seq.*, was recently amended to authorize the Corporate Authorities to impose a fee of up to two hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00) for the operation of each video gaming terminal in the Village, 230 ILCS 40/65;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Campton Hills, Kane County, Illinois, as follows:

**Section 1.** That the above recitals and legislative findings are found to be true and correct and are hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in their entirety.

**Section 2.** Section 4-5-3 ("*Fees*") of Chapter 5 ("*Video Gaming*") of Title 4 ("*Business and License Regulations*") of the Village Code of Campton Hills, Illinois, is hereby amended by deleting the stricken language and by adding the underlined language to read, as follows:

**4-5-3: REGULATIONS:**

An annual fee of ~~twenty-five dollars (\$25.00)~~ two hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00) is hereby imposed on each video gaming terminal operated within the Village. The annual fee must be paid at the time of submission of an application for a video gaming license, and annually thereafter.

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**Section 3.** This new annual fee will become effective on Jan 4, 2022.

**Section 4.** If any section, paragraph, clause, or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any other provision of this Ordinance.

**Section 5.** All ordinances, resolutions, motions, or orders in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict

**Section 6.** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval, and publication in the manner provided by law.
