

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 6 “POLICE AND PUBLIC SAFETY” OF THE VILLAGE CODE OF CAMPTON HILLS, KANE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, TO PROVIDE FOR THE POSITION OF POLICE COMMANDER IN THE VILLAGE.**

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Campton Hills, Kane County, Illinois (the “*Village*”) is a duly organized and existing municipal corporation created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois and under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, as from time to time supplemented and amended; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Campton Hills, Kane County, Illinois (the “*Corporate Authorities*”) may from time to time amend the text of the Village Code of Campton Hills (the “*Code*”) when it is determined to be in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the Village and its residents; and

**WHEREAS**, the Corporate Authorities find that the efficient operations and organization of the Village’s Police Department require a new position be created within the Department; and

**WHEREAS**, the Corporate Authorities find that it is in the best interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the Village to amend the Village Code to provide for the position of Police Commander within the Police Department.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Campton Hills, Kane County, Illinois, as follows:

**Section 1.** That the above recitals and legislative findings are found to be true and correct and are hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in their entirety.

**Section 2.** Chapter 1 (“*Police Department*”) of Title 6 (“*Police and Public Safety*”) of the Village Code of Campton Hills, Illinois, is hereby amended by adding the underlined language immediately following Section 6-1-4 of the Village Code:

**6-1-4A: POLICE COMMANDER**

A. Office Created; Appointment: There is hereby created the position of and office of police commander, limited to one such person. The police commander shall be appointed and removed by the chief of police. Provided, that if the person appointed as police commander was at the time of such appointment a member of the department, he shall retain his status and rank while serving as police commander and shall revert to such status and rank when his term as police commander has ended.

B. Powers and Duties: The police commander shall have such powers and duties as shall be delegated in writing to such person by the chief of police from time to time.

**Section 3.** If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any other provision of this Ordinance.

**Section 4.** All ordinances, resolutions, motions or orders in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

**Section 5.** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval, and publication in the manner provided by law.
