

ORDINANCE NO. O-22-14

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 1 OF TITLE 4 OF THE VILLAGE CODE OF CAMPTON HILLS, KANE COUNTY, ILLINOIS ESTABLISHING THE NUMBER OF AVAILABLE LIQUOR LICENSES

WHEREAS, the Village of Campton Hills, Kane County, Illinois (the "*Village*") is a duly organized and existing municipal corporation created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois and under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, as from time to time supplemented and amended; and

WHEREAS, Article IV of the Liquor Control Act of 1934, 235 ILCS 5/4-1, et seq. (the "*Act*"), authorizes the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Campton Hills (the "*Corporate Authorities*") to determine the number, kind and classification of licenses for the retail sale of alcoholic liquor and to establish such further regulations and restrictions upon the issuance of and operations under local licenses not inconsistent with law as the public good and convenience may require; and

WHEREAS, several licensees have not renewed their respective liquor licenses in the Village or are not operational at their premises and are therefore no longer eligible for a liquor license in accordance with the Village Code of Campton Hills; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities find that it is in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village to amend the Village Code of Campton Hills to accurately reflect the number of liquor licenses in the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Campton Hills, Kane County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. That the above recitals and legislative findings are found to be true and correct and are hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in their entirety.

Section 2. Section 4-1-12 (“*Number of Licenses*”) of Chapter 1 (“*Alcoholic Beverages*”) of Title 4 (“*Business and License Regulations*”) of the Village Code of Campton Hills, Illinois, ~~is hereby amended by deleting the following stricken language and adding the underlined~~ language to read, as follows: ^{12/6/2022}

4-1-12: NUMBER OF LICENSES:

- (b) *Reduction in the number of licenses.* Whenever a license previously issued under this chapter is revoked, surrendered, nonrenewed or terminated by dormancy, the maximum number of licenses in the class of the license which is revoked, surrendered, nonrenewed or terminated by dormancy shall be automatically and immediately reduced by one.
- (c) *Appropriate number of licenses.* Upon revocation, surrender, nonrenewal or termination by dormancy, the village clerk shall codify the appropriate maximum number of licenses for each class whenever the number of license(s) is reduced by this section.

Section 3. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any other provision of this Ordinance.

Section 4. All ordinances, resolutions, motions or orders in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict

Section 5. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval, and publication in the manner provided by law.
