

**VILLAGE OF CAMPTON HILLS
ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE I OF THE VILLAGE OF CAMPTON HILLS CODE BY
ADDING A NEW CHAPTER 19, ATTENDANCE AT THE MEETINGS OF THE
CORPORATE AUTHORITIES, PLAN COMMISSION AND ZONING BOARD OF
APPEALS BY AUDIO CONFERENCING**

WHEREAS, attendance by audio conferencing is permitted, with conditions, by the Open Meetings Act (5 ILCS 120/7):

Now Therefore, Be it Ordained by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Campton Hills, Kane County, Illinois, that:

SECTION 1. Title I of the Village Code is hereby amended to provide for a new Chapter 19 as follows:

**CHAPTER 19
ATTENDANCE AT THE MEETINGS OF THE CORPORATE AUTHORITIES, PLAN
COMMISSION AND ZONING BOARD OF APPEALS BY AUDIO CONFERENCING**

If any member of the Corporate Authorities, Plan Commission or Zoning Board of Appeals is unable to attend a meeting of such body in person, such member may attend such meeting by audio conferencing subject to the following rules and limitations:

- A. If a quorum of the members of such body is physically present at the place designated in the notice of meeting, a majority of such body may adopt a motion to allow a member of that body to attend the meeting by audio conferencing if such member is prevented from physically attending because of:
 1. Personal illness or disability;
 2. Employment purposes or the business of the Village; or
 3. A family or other emergency.
- B. Such member shall notify the Village Clerk (in the case of the Corporate Authorities) or the recording secretary of the Plan Commission or Zoning Board of Appeals in the case of membership in those bodies, prior to the meeting unless advance notice is impractical.
- C. In addition to the foregoing rules and regulations, the following shall apply to any meeting where a member of the Corporate Authorities, Plan Commission or

Zoning Board of Appeals, as may be applicable, is attending by audio conferencing:

1. During any meeting where such member participates by audio conferencing, all votes shall be taken by roll call.
2. In the event that the meeting is or includes a public hearing, all persons present at such public hearing, including the public, will be allowed to participate in the audio conference.
3. To the extent practical, a copy of all documents being reviewed, discussed or adopted by the Corporate Authorities, Plan Commission or Zoning Board of Appeals, as may be applicable, shall be available to the member participating by audio conferencing.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall be full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law. This Ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form.
