

**VILLAGE CODE AMENDMENT
VILLAGE OF CAMPTON HILLS
AMENDMENT TO SECTION 3-1-5P-C and 3-1-5Q(d)**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CAMPTON HILLS, KANE COUNTY, ILLINOIS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Section 3-1-5P-C of the Village Code which now provides:

“C. Such bond must have a coverage period equal to or longer than the duration of the applicant’s liquor license,”

is hereby amended and restated to provide as follows:

C. Such bond must have a coverage period equal to or longer than the duration of the applicant’s liquor license, provided that such requirement may be waived if the applicant presents evidence satisfactory to the Liquor Control Commissioner that the applicant holds a liquor license at a location other than the Village of Campton Hills, pays an administrative fee to the Village in the amount of \$25.00 and agrees in writing to furnish the required policy of insurance, or a renewal of the then existing policy, not less than 14 days prior to the expiration of the policy presented with the liquor license application; and provided further that if the license holder fails to produce such new policy or extended policy of insurance prior to the said 14 day period, the license holder shall pay a penalty of \$50.00 per day to the Village.

SECTION 2: Section 3.1-5Q(d) of the Village Code which now provides:

(d) Each applicant shall show by evidence satisfactory to the Local Liquor Control Commissioner, the issuance of a policy of liquor liability insurance, and in the event he is not the owner of the premises described in said application, that he has a lawful right to possession of the same until the expiration of the term of license for which application is made. In the event of cancellation, the Local Liquor Control Commissioner shall be notified immediately of such cancellation,

is hereby amended and restated to provide as follows:

d) Each applicant shall show by evidence satisfactory to the Local Liquor Control Commissioner, of the existence of a policy of liquor liability insurance, and in the event the applicant is not the owner of the premises described in said application, that such applicant has a lawful right to possession of the same until the expiration of the term of license for which

application is made; provided that the requirement of a coverage period equal to or longer than the duration of the applicant's liquor license may be waived if the applicant presents evidence satisfactory to the Liquor Control Commissioner that the applicant holds a liquor license at a location other than the Village of Campton Hills, pays an administrative fee to the Village in the amount of \$25.00 and agrees in writing to furnish the required policy of insurance, or a renewal of the then existing policy, not less than 14 days prior to the expiration of the policy presented with the liquor license application; and provided further that if the license holder fails to produce such new policy or extended policy of insurance prior to the said 14 day period, the license holder shall pay a penalty of \$50.00 per day to the Village. In the event of cancellation of the lease or other evidence of a lawful right to possession of the premises, the Local Liquor Control Commissioner shall be notified immediately of such cancellation.

SECTION 3: Any motion, order, resolution or ordinance in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance is, to the extent of such conflict, hereby superseded and waived.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take full force and effect upon its passage, approval and publication as provided by law. This Ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form.


