VILLAGE OF CAMPTON HILLS  
AMENDMENT TO SECTION 1-14-10, HIRING STANDARDS FOR  
PART-TIME POLICE OFFICERS

WHEREAS, 65ILCS 5/3.1-30-21 provides the municipalities employing part-time police officers shall, by ordinance, establish hiring standards for part-time police officers and shall submit those standards to the Illinois Law Enforcement Training Standards Board:

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CAMPTON HILLS, KANE COUNTY, ILLINOIS AS FOLLOWS:

**SECTION 1.** Section 1-14-10 of the Village Code is amended and restated to provide as follows:

1. **Employment.** The Village may employ part-time police officers from time to time as the Village deems necessary and convenient.
2. **Duties.** A part-time police officer shall have all the responsibilities of a full-time police officer and such specific duties as delineated in the General Orders of the Campton Hills Police Department, but the number of hours a part-time officer may work within a calendar year is restricted. Part-time police officers shall not be assigned to supervise or direct full-time police officers. Part-time police officers shall be trained in accordance with the Illinois Police Training Act (50 ILCS 705/1 et. seq.) and the rules and requirements of the Illinois Law Enforcement Training Standards Board.
3. **Hiring Standards.** Any person employed as a part-time police officer must meet the following standards:
  1. Be of good moral character, of temperate habits, of sound health, and physically and mentally able to perform assigned duties.
  2. Be at least twenty-one (21) years of age.
  3. Pass a medical examination.
  4. Pass a background investigation
  5. Possess a high school diploma or GED certificate.
  6. Possess a valid State of Illinois driver's license.
  7. Have no felony convictions.
  8. If an individual who has served in the U.S. military, must have been honorably discharged.

D. Discipline. Part-time officers shall be under the disciplinary jurisdiction of the Chief of Police. Part-time police officers serve at the discretion of the Corporate Authorities, shall not have any property rights in said employment, and may be removed by the Corporate Authorities at any time. Part-time police officers shall comply with all applicable rules and General Orders issued by the Police Department.

**SECTION 2.** This Ordinance shall take full force and effect upon its passage, approval and publication as provided by law. This Ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form.
