

VILLAGE OF CAMPTON HILLS

**AN ORDINANCE DELETING SECTION 1-6-5(C) OF THE
VILLAGE CODE AND ADDING A NEW CHAPTER 20 TO TITLE 1 THEREOF
"RULES FOR ADDRESSING PUBLIC OFFICIALS AT ALL MEETINGS"**

WHEREAS, Section 120/2.06(g) of the Open Meetings Act of the State of Illinois (5 ILCS 120/2.06(g)) provides "Any person shall be permitted an opportunity to address public officials under the rules established and recorded by the public body"; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities have determined that it is in the public interest that there be uniform rules governing the subject which will apply to the Corporate Authorities and all commissions, committees, subcommittees and boards of the Village:

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CAMPTON HILLS, KANE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 1-6-5(C) the Village Code is hereby deleted.

Section 2. There is hereby added to the Village Code a new Chapter 20 to Title 1 thereof, as follows:

Chapter 20.

ADDRESSING PUBLIC OFFICIALS AT MEETINGS

1-20-1. Applicability to all Village meetings. The rules set forth in this Chapter apply to all meetings of the Corporate Authorities and all commissions, boards, committees and sub-committees of the Village (all of which are hereinafter referred to in this Chapter as "public bodies").

1-20-2. Each public body of the Village may, in its discretion, adopt rules regulating the manner in which members of the public may address such public bodies, provided that such rules shall, in no case, be more restrictive than those provided in Section 1-20-3 of this Chapter. The following rules shall apply to all public bodies of the Village which have not adopted specific rules and no such specific rules shall be more restrictive than those set forth in this Section.

a. Any person desiring to address the public body shall complete a sign up form for that purpose, if requested to do so by the public body.

b. Unless otherwise specified by the agenda, the rules of the public body or by the Chairperson of the public body, the right to address the

public body shall occur during the portion of the meeting immediately following the roll call and establishment of a quorum of the public body.

c. Any person addressing the public body shall do so for not more than three (3) minutes, unless such time limit is waived by the Chairperson of the meeting.

d. Any person addressing the public body should avoid remarks which are clearly repetitious to the remarks of those of other persons having previously addressed the public body at the same meeting and the Chairperson may take reasonable steps to limit clearly repetitious remarks.


e. No person may address the public body in the manner which is threatening to any person (whether or not a member of the public body) or which includes profanity after having been requested to cease such profanity.

f. To the extent that the provisions of this Chapter conflict with the provisions of any statute which specifically provides for the right to address a public body as to specific issues, such as but not limited to, public hearings, the more liberal provisions of this Chapter or such specific statute shall govern.


