

**AN ORDINANCE
AMENDING TITLE 3 OF THE VILLAGE CODE
REGARDING LIQUOR CONTROL REGULATIONS**

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees (the “*Corporate Authorities*”) of the Village of Campton Hills, Kane County, Illinois (the “*Village*”) desire to amend Title 3 of the Campton Hills Village Code regarding liquor control regulations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Campton Hills, Kane County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. That Section 3-1-5G of the Village Code entitled “Classification of Retail Liquor Licenses” is hereby amended by amending the following paragraphs entitled “Class AR Licenses”, “Class M Licenses”, “Class Q-1 Licenses”, and “Class Q-2 Licenses” and adding the following paragraph entitled “Class ARPQ Licenses” as follows:

“Class AR Licenses (Restaurants): Such licenses shall authorize the retail sale of all kinds of alcoholic liquor in a restaurant for consumption on the premises.

Class M Licenses (Market): Such license shall authorize the retail sale of all kinds of alcoholic liquor for consumption on the premises and the retail sale of all types of alcoholic liquor for consumption off the premises so long as the following apply: (1) the products sold for consumption off the premises are not opened and consumed on the premises, (2) the total square footage of the premises dedicated for the retail sale of alcoholic liquor off the premises is no more than one-third of the total square footage of the premises, and (3) permitted goods and merchandise, other than alcoholic liquor, is also offered for retail sale on the premises.

Class Q-1 Licenses (Product Sampling & Tasting Events): Such license shall authorize product sampling for consumption of beer and wine only within the premises and/or within the property lines of the property upon which the premises is located of up to three (3) samples of no more than one (1) ounce of wine or two (2) ounces of beer per consumer per day. A Class Q-1 licensee may offer for sale and serve more than one (1) drink per person for sampling purposes provided the total quantity of the sampling package regardless of the number of containers in which the alcoholic liquor is served does not exceed four (4) ounces of wine or sixteen (16) ounces of beer and shall be available only to Class AW licensees. A separate Class P license must be obtained for outside service.

Class Q-2 Licenses (Temporary Product Sampling & Tasting Event): Such license shall authorize product sampling for consumption of alcoholic liquor within the premises only of up to three (3) samples of no more than one quarter (1/4) ounce of distilled spirits, (1) ounce of wine, or two (2) ounces of beer per consumer per day. A Class Q-2 licensee may offer for sale and serve more than one (1) drink per person for sampling purposes provided the total quantity of the sampling package regardless of the number of containers in which the alcoholic liquor is served does not exceed one (1) ounce of distilled spirits, four (4) ounces of wine, or sixteen (16) ounces of beer and shall be available only to Class AR, AW, AP, C, or C-1 licensees. Product sampling events must be registered with the Local Liquor Control Commissioner no later than forty-eight hours prior to the event.

Class ARPQ Licenses (Packaged Sales in Restaurants): Such license shall authorize the retail sale of all types of alcoholic liquor for consumption off the premises only when a Class Q-2 License has been issued and the alcoholic liquor being offered for sale is the alcoholic liquor being offered for product sampling and is sold only during the time of the tasting event. Such license shall only be available to Class AR licensees.”

Section 2. That Section 3-1-5I of the Village Code entitled “Fees for Licenses and Renewal Fees” is hereby amended by amending the fees and terms for “Class AB&W”, “Class M” and “Class Q-T ” licenses and adding the fee and term for “Class ARPQ “ licenses as follows:

“Class AB&W	\$2,000.00	Per year. The per year fee for Class AR Licensees shall be \$750.00.
Class ARPQ	\$500.00	Per year
Class M	\$3,500.00	Per year
Class Q-2	\$75.00	Per event. The per event fee for Class APRQ Licensees shall be waived.”

Section 3. All ordinances, resolutions, motions or parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and approval and publication as provided by law. This ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form.
