

**AN ORDINANCE  
AMENDING VILLAGE CODE SECTIONS 1-5-1, 1-7-4, 1-9-1, AND 10-1-2  
RELATIVE TO SURETY BONDS REQUIRED OF CERTAIN OFFICERS**

**SECTION 1:** Section 1-5-1 of the Village Code of the Village of Campton Hills is hereby deleted in its entirety and the following is inserted in lieu thereof:

“Before entering upon the duties of his office, the President shall give a bond with sureties to be approved by the Board of Trustees, conditioned upon his or her faithful performance of his or her duties, in the sum set forth in Section 1-7-4 herein; He shall take the “Oath Of Office” as prescribed by statute and shall receive such compensation as may be set from time to time by the Board as provided by law.

**SECTION 2:** Section 1-7-4 of the Village Code of the Village of Campton Hills is hereby amended by the deletion of paragraph B in its entirety and the following paragraphs B and C are inserted in lieu thereof:

“B. Bond: Every officer and employee shall, if required by the Corporate Authorities or state statute, prior to entering upon the duties of his office, give a bond in such sum as set forth in this Section, such sureties to be rated AA-1 or better, conditioned upon the faithful performance of the duties of his or her office or position, to be approved by the Corporate Authorities.

C. Amount of Bond. Each officer or employee of the Village specified herein shall post a surety bond in the following sum:

Chief of Police:	\$25,000
Collector, if applicable:	\$50,000
Deputy Village Clerk:	\$25,000
Finance Trustee, if applicable:	\$50,000
Fire and Police Commissioners	\$10,000
Village Administrator:	\$50,000
Village Clerk:	\$50,000
Village President:	\$50,000
Village Treasurer:	\$50,000”

**SECTION 3:** Section 1-9-2 of the Village Code of the Village of Campton Hills is hereby deleted in its entirety and the following is inserted in lieu thereof:

“1-9-2 BOND:

The Village Treasurer shall give a surety bond, before entering upon the duties of his office, in the sum set forth in Section 1-7-4, but such amount shall not be less than that required by state statute. This bond shall be conditioned upon the faithful performance of his/her duties as the Treasurer and shall be conditioned to indemnify the Village for any loss by reason of any neglect of duty or any improper act of the Treasurer."

**SECTION 4:** Section 1-10-2 of the Village Code of the Village of Campton Hills, is hereby deleted in its entirety and the following is inserted in lieu thereof:

**"1-10-2 BOND:**

The Village Clerk, or Collector if applicable, shall give a surety bond before entering upon the duties of the office, in the sum set forth in Section 1-7-4, but such amount shall not be less than that required by state statute. This bond shall be conditioned upon the faithful performance of the Clerk/Collector's duties as the Clerk/Collector, and shall be conditioned to indemnify the Village for any loss by reason of any neglect of duty or any act of the Clerk/Collector."

**SECTION 5:** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and approval and publication as provided by law. This ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form.


