

ORDINANCE NO. O-11-12

**ORDINANCE AMENDING THE VILLAGE CODE
OF THE VILLAGE OF CAMPTON HILLS,
KANE COUNTY, ILLINOIS
(Deletion of Section 1-6-5C; Addition of
Chapter 20 to Title I Relative to Persons
Permitted an Opportunity to Address Meetings)**

WHEREAS, the Open Meetings Act of the State of Illinois was amended by Public Act 096-1473 to provide:

“(g) Any person shall be permitted an opportunity to address public officials under the rules established and recorded by the public body”; and

WHEREAS, since the incorporation of the Village of Campton Hills, persons have been permitted to speak at meetings of the Corporate Authorities, Plan Commission, Zoning Board of Appeals and of other committees, subcommittees and commissions:

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Campton Hills, Kane County, Illinois that:

SECTION 1. Section 1-6-5C of the Village Code is hereby deleted and an entry shall be made next to Section 1-6-5C as follows:

“There is no subsection C to Section 1-6-5”

SECTION 2. Title I of the Village Code of the Village of Campton Hills is hereby amended to add a new Chapter 20 as follows:

Chapter 20.

Persons Permitted an Opportunity to Address Public Officials:

1-20-1. General Authority to Speak

A. Speaking at all meetings permitted.

Any person shall be permitted an opportunity to speak at any regular meeting of the Corporate Authorities and any meeting of the Plan Commission, Zoning Board of Appeals or any other Committee, Subcommittee or Commission of the Village.

B. Corporate Authorities

1. Where there are a Committee of the Whole or Regular or Special Board Meetings of the Corporate Authorities on the same date, the opportunity to address the Corporate Authorities shall be at the Regular or Special Board Meeting except that the Village President may allow comments from the audience at the discretion of the President during a Committee of the Whole Meeting.

2. Any person wishing to address the Corporate Authorities shall complete and present a form which provides the name and address of the person wishing to speak (to assist the Village Clerk in maintaining proper records) and such other information as specified by the Village President.

3. Remarks of any person speaking shall be limited to three (3) minutes.

4. The total time allotted for addressing the Corporate Authorities shall be thirty (30) minutes at any meeting; additional time may be permitted at the discretion of the President.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall be full force and effect upon its passage and approval and publication pursuant to law.
