

AN ORDINANCE
AMENDING THE VILLAGE CODE
SECTIONS 7-2-2B and 7-2-3
(Burning of Manure)

WHEREAS, burning of manure may be injurious to public health and produces offensive odors:

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CAMPTON HILLS, KANE COUNTY, ILLINOIS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Section 7-2-2B of the Village Code is amended to add thereto immediately following:

"**Burning of Garbage:** To burn garbage or rubbish outdoors with the exception of brush,"

a new clause as follows:

"**Burning of Manure:** To burn manure outdoors."

SECTION 2: The first sentence of Section 7-2-3 of the Village Code which now provides:

"The terms and provisions of this Chapter shall not apply to property which is both zoned and used for any agricultural purpose:"

Is hereby amended and restated to provide as follows:

"The terms and provisions of this Chapter shall not apply to property which is both zoned and used for any agricultural purpose, except that the following portion of Section 7-2-2B shall apply to such property:

1. The second clause of Section 7-2-2B, which provides "Burning of Manure: To burn manure outdoors."

SECTION 3. Any motion, order, resolution or ordinance in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance is, to the extent of such conflict, hereby superseded and waived.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take full force and effect upon its passage, approval and publication as provided by law. Publication shall be in pamphlet form.
