

ORDINANCE NO. O-20-02

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 7 OF THE VILLAGE CODE OF CAMPTON HILLS, KANE COUNTY, ILLINOIS RELATING TO PROHIBITED PARKING RULES

WHEREAS, the Village of Campton Hills, Kane County, Illinois (the "*Village*") is a duly organized and existing municipal corporation created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois and under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, as from time to time supplemented and amended; and

WHEREAS, the Village President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Campton Hills, Kane County, Illinois (the "*Corporate Authorities*") may from time to time amend the text of the Village Code of Campton Hills (the "*Code*") when it is determined to be in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the Village and its residents; and

WHEREAS, the Village currently prohibits parking in certain areas of the Village; and

WHEREAS, Campton Township has suggested that the Code, concerning parking prohibitions, be modified to address narrow roadways in the Fox Mill (Farmstead Phase) Subdivision; and the Village wishes to refine its parking restrictions relating to the same; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities find that it is in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village to provide for the regulations herein specified.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Campton Hills, Kane County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. That the above recitals and legislative findings are found to be true and correct and are hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in their entirety.

Section 2. Section 7-4-1 ("*Stopping, Standing, or Parking Prohibited*") of Chapter 4

("Parking Regulations") of Title 7 ("Motor Vehicles and Traffic") of the Village Code of Campton Hills, Illinois, is hereby amended by adding the language as follows:

7-4-1: Stopping, Standing, or Parking Prohibited:

A. It shall be unlawful at all times to stop, stand or park a vehicle in any of the following places:

13. Within the Fox Mill (Farmstead Phase) Subdivision, such areas of streets where official "No Parking" signs have been posted pursuant to the Highway Commissioner's discretion.

a. The Fox Mill (Farmstead Phase) Subdivision streets are as follows:

<u>East Laura Ingalls Wilder Drive</u>	<u>- Joyce Kilmer Court</u>
<u>West Laura Ingalls Wilder Drive</u>	<u>- Francis Bret Harte Street</u>
<u>Vachel Lindsay Street</u>	<u>- Edna St. Vincent Millay Street</u>
<u>Taylor Caldwell Street</u>	<u>- Edgar Lee Masters Street</u>
<u>Oliver Wendell Holmes Street</u>	

Section 3. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any other provision of this Ordinance.

Section 4. All ordinances, resolutions, motions or orders in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.


Section 5. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval, and publication in the manner provided by law.
