

**VILLAGE OF CAMPTON HILLS, ILLINOIS
ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE TERMINATION OF SPECIAL SERVICE AREA NUMBER ONE –
(Portions of Evening Prairie Subdivision, Verhaeghe Subdivision and Adjacent Areas –
Stormwater Management and Drainage Facilities)
ESTABLISHED PURSUANT TO
ORDINANCE # O-08-14 ON MAY 6, 2008**

WHEREAS, the Village of Campton Hills ("Village") is a non-home rule municipality operating under the Illinois Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, the Village has heretofore established Special Service Area Number One (Portions of Evening Prairie Subdivision, Verhaeghe Subdivision and Adjacent Areas – Stormwater Management and Drainage Facilities) in the Village of Campton Hills pursuant to Ordinance # O-08-14, on May 6, 2008, attached hereto as Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, the Village has heretofore authorized the borrowing of an amount not to exceed the amounts set forth in Ordinance #O-08-28, on August 26, 2008, attached hereto as Exhibit B, for a term not to exceed ten (10) years; and

WHEREAS, the total cost of the project funded by Special Service Area Number One has been paid for in total and not further debt or levy is needed.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Campton Hills, County of Kane, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1:

That Special Service Area Number One in the Village of Campton Hills, previously established pursuant to Ordinance # O-08-14, is hereby terminated as of April 30, 2020, and there shall be no debt or levy on the property located in Special Service Area Number Three for the 2019 levy year payable in 2020, and thereafter.

Section 2:

That, pursuant to 35 ILCS 200/27-93, all excess revenues which exist in the applicable special service area fund, less any statutory permitted Village administrative fees to be transferred to the Village General Fund, shall be refunded to the affected taxpayers of record for all parcels within the special service area, as of the date of this Ordinance, on a pro rata basis based upon each parcel's proportionate share of the total equalized assessed valuation of all parcels within the special service area. In accordance herewith, Village staff shall promptly pay any excess funds to the Kane County Treasurer with a direction to disburse the funds in provided in this Section 2.

Section 3:

That a certified copy of this Ordinance be filed forthwith with the County Clerk of Kane County and recorded with the County Recorder's Office of Kane County, Illinois.


Section 3:
