

**AN ORDINANCE TEMPORARILY AMENDING LIQUOR LICENSE FEES
REQUIRED BY TITLE 4, SECTION 4-1-11 "LICENSE FEES" OF THE VILLAGE
CODE OF CAMPTON HILLS, KANE COUNTY, ILLINOIS.**

WHEREAS, the Village of Campton Hills, Kane County, Illinois (the "*Village*") is a duly organized and existing municipal corporation created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois and under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, as from time to time supplemented and amended; and

WHEREAS, the Village President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Campton Hills, Kane County, Illinois (the "*Corporate Authorities*") may from time to time amend the text of the Village Code of Campton Hills (the "*Code*") when it is determined to be in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the Village and its residents; and

WHEREAS, the COVID-19 crises, and ensuing Executive Orders issued by the Governor of the State of Illinois, have negatively impacted business in the Village, affecting the manner in which business is conducted and leading to a substantial loss in local business income; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities seek to provide some monetary relief to Village restaurants and outdoor service areas by reducing certain fees to restaurants and outside service areas within the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities find that it is in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village to amend the Village's Liquor License Fees for restaurants and outside service areas.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Campton Hills, Kane County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. That the above recitals and legislative findings are found to be true and correct and are hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in their entirety.

Section 2. That the License Fee for a Class AR License (Restaurant) of Title 4 Section 4-1-11 “License Fees” of the Village Code of Campton Hills, Kane County, Illinois is hereby reduced from \$2,500 per year to \$10 per year.

Section 3. That the License Fee for a Class P License (Outside Service) of Title 4 Section 4-1-11 “License Fees” of the Village Code of Campton Hills, Kane County, Illinois is hereby reduced from \$100 per year to \$10 per year.

Section 4. The provisions of this Ordinance and reduction in license fees shall expire at midnight on April 30, 2022 unless earlier repealed or extended by subsequent Village Ordinance.

Section 5. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any other provision of this Ordinance.

Section 6. All ordinances, resolutions, motions or orders in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.


Section 7. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval, and publication in the manner provided by law.
