

**AN ORDINANCE REAUTHORIZING AND EXTENDING THE VIDEO GAMING
ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE CODE OF CAMPTON HILLS, KANE COUNTY,
ILLINOIS.**

WHEREAS, the Village of Campton Hills, Kane County, Illinois (the "*Village*") is a duly organized and existing municipal corporation created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois and under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, as from time to time supplemented and amended; and

WHEREAS, the Village President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Campton Hills, Kane County, Illinois (the "*Corporate Authorities*") may from time to time amend the text of the Village Code of Campton Hills (the "*Code*") when it is determined to be in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the Village and its residents; and

WHEREAS, on April 16, 2019 the Village passed Ordinance No. O-19-01, amending the Code and permitting Video Gaming in the Village under certain terms and conditions. See Exhibit A, a copy of said Ordinance, attached hereto; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. O-19-01 automatically repeals unless reauthorized by Village Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the COVID-19 crises, and ensuing Executive Orders issued by the Governor of the State of Illinois, have negatively impacted business in the Village, affecting the manner in which business is conducted and leading to a substantial loss in local business income; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities seek to provide some monetary relief to Village businesses by extending the Village's Video Gaming Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities find that it is in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village to extend the Village's Video Gaming Ordinance for those businesses that qualify.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Campton Hills, Kane County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. That the above recitals and legislative findings are found to be true and correct and are hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in their entirety.

Section 2. That Ordinance No. O-19-01 is hereby reauthorized and extended through April 30, 2022, at which time it will automatically be repealed unless reauthorized by an Ordinance enacted by the Village Board.

Section 3. That all of the terms and conditions of said Ordinance No. O-19-01 shall remain in full force and effect through April 30, 2022, unless earlier repealed or extended by subsequent Village Ordinance.

Section 4. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any other provision of this Ordinance.

Section 5. All ordinances, resolutions, motions or orders in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 6. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval, and publication in the manner provided by law.
