

**A RESOLUTION  
CREATING A CENSUS 2020 COMPLETE COUNT  
AD-HOC COMMITTEE TO PLAN AND CONDUCT  
LOCAL EDUCATIONAL INITIATIVES, PUBLICITY AND  
PROMOTIONAL ACTIVITIES TO INCREASE COMMUNITY  
AWARENESS AND PARTICIPATION IN THE 2020 CENSUS**

**WHEREAS**, the U.S. Census Bureau is required by the U.S. Constitution to conduct a count of the population and provides a historic opportunity to help shape the foundation of our society and play an active role in American democracy;

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Campton Hills, IL is committed to ensuring every resident is counted;

**WHEREAS** federal and state funding is allocated to communities, and decisions are made on matters of national and local importance based, in part, on census data and housing;

**WHEREAS** census data helps determine how many seats each state will have in the U.S. House of Representatives and is necessary for an accurate and fair redistricting of state legislative seats, county and city councils and voting districts;

**WHEREAS** information from the 2020 Census and American Community Survey are vital tools for economic development and increased employment;

**WHEREAS** the information collected by the census is confidential and protected by law;

**WHEREAS** a united voice from business, government, community-based and faith-based organizations, educators, media and others will enable the 2020 Census message to reach more of our citizens;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Village of Campton Hills, IL is committed to partnering with the U.S. Census Bureau and the State of Illinois and will:

**Section 1. Establishment and Purpose.** The Village Board of Trustees hereby establishes a *Complete Count Committee (CCC)* with a purpose as follows:

- Support the goals and ideals for the 2020 Census and will disseminate 2020 Census information.
- Encourage all Village residents to participate in events and initiatives that will raise the overall awareness of the 2020 Census and increase participation.
- Provide Census advocates to speak to Village and Community Organizations.
- Support census takers as they help our Village complete an accurate count.
- Strive to achieve a complete and accurate count of all persons within our borders

**Section 2. Composition.** The Village Board of Trustees hereby formalizes the establishment of a *CCC* as follows:

- *Five (5)* Members.
- Members will serve for the duration of the Census 2020 effort, up to a two (2) year term or whichever is shorter.
- *Three* members of the *CCC Committee* will constitute a quorum.
- Members will serve until their successors are appointed and confirmed, unless removed by the Village President.


**Section 3. Meetings.** The *CCC Committee* is subject to the Illinois Open Meetings Act, and all meetings will comply with the provisions of that Act.

**Section 4.** This resolution shall take full force and effect upon its passage and approval as provided by law.
